Jersey Village Area Lake Restocked for Fishing

(Houston, TX) – Continuing rains and healthy lake conditions have created the perfect environment to restock some area lakes. And, Harris County Precinct 4 Commissioner R. Jack Cagle is taking advantage of those conditions.

Commissioner R. Jack Cagle took part in the process of restocking the Bane Park Lake near Jersey Village on Tuesday. The five-acre, wheelchair-accessible fishing lake which is home to catfish, bass and trout, received an additional 100 bass and 400 catfish.

“Precinct 4 staff works to manage Bane Lake at an optimum level for local wildlife in an urban area while maintaining a great fishing environment,” according to Cagle.

Cagle added that anglers are asked to catch and release the bass as part of the county’s efforts to maintain the lake environment at its healthiest level.

Bane Park, located at 9600 W. Little York Road is inside Beltway 8 near the northwest corner of the Beltway and HWY 290. The 18.2 acre park includes the wheelchair-accessible lake, covered picnic pavilions, a playground and splash pad, barbecue and picnic tables, a rock climbing wall, sand volleyball court, natural and paved surface walking trails, and rest room facilities.
